Our team looked at data comparing older adults with dementia matched to people without dementia over a period of 7 years

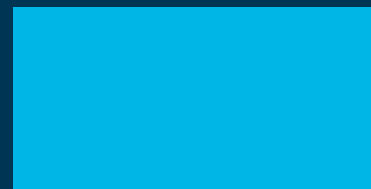

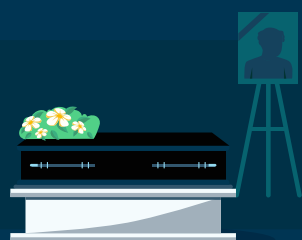

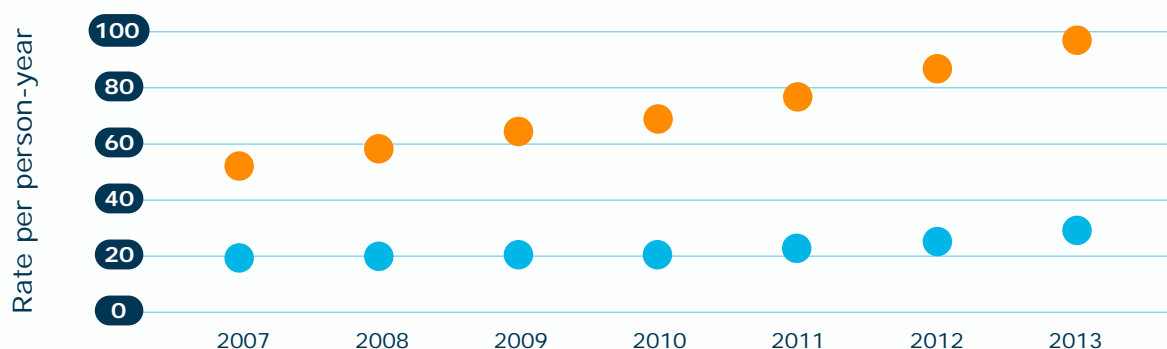

Home Care Visits

Use of home care services increased more rapidly over time for **people with dementia** than those **without dementia**



This research shows that home care service use increased over time for people with dementia who continued to live in the community, highlighting the need for this type of care
